- Buoyancy of 48” SWMU – Spicer reviewed the buoyancy issue and advised that they will need 12.5 yard of concrete to hold the SWMU down.
- Spicer advised that at Ashley Capital II site (not part of the Carrier Creek Project) someone stuffed a steel pipe into a concrete pipe, so sedimentation is entering between the steel and concrete pipe.
- Millett Pipe – Spicer advised that the pipe needs to be cleaned out, but since it’s not part of the Carrier Creek Project, it is not the responsibility of Eaton County/Carrier Creek.
- Pumping – Spicer inquired as to whether the water can be pumped into a sump and then discharged into a silt fence on Branch No. 1.
